## GCSE grading system.

SINCE 2017 ALL GCSES ARE MARKED IN NUMERICAL GRADES 9-1

Student's current flightpaths correspond to their estimated GCSE performance.

## HOW IS SUCCESS MEASURED AT GCSE?

- Achievement in eight best subjects.
- This includes English, Maths, EBAC subjects and 'other' subjects.
- Students will have to re-take English and Maths, post 16 if they don't get a 4 at GCSE.
- Check A level requirements

## TECHNICAL AWARDS AND OCR NATIONALS

In addition to GCSEs, there are Technical Awards and OCR Nationals which can be found in more practical or work related subjects.

These still count towards Progress and Achievement 8 and will count for getting onto post 16 courses.

They may still have exams, but will have a greater coursework element.


## MILLAIS SCHOOL

WHY 10 GCSES?
10 subjects is challenging.
Fewer than 10 limits your choices.
Sixth forms (\& universities) will look at individual subject grades.

You will maximise your achievement.


## MILLAIS SCHOOL

## WHAT SUBJECTS DO I HAVE TO TAKE?

All pupils study several compulsory GCSEs

- English Language
- English Literature
- Mathematics
- Science - leading to two GCSEs

- One Modern Foreign Language


## MILLAIS SCHOOL

## THE REMAINING COURSES THAT ARE COMPULSORY ARE...

- Physical Education
- Personal Development
- There is no exam for either of these.



## MILLAIS SCHOOL

## WHAT IS THE ENGLISH BACCALAUREATE?

Pupils will gain an accreditation called the English Baccalaureate provided they gain a grade 4 or above in:


History or Geography
This can influence post 18 choices

## EXAMPLE STUDENT TIMETABLE

|  | C Block | D Block | E Block | F Block | G Block |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Student A | Spanish | History | Drama | Art | GCSE PE |
| Student B | History | Spanish | GCSE PE | Drama | Art |

Some subjects are designed and run for students of certain abilities. We also have limitations on rooms, facilitates and how many teachers can teach each option subject.

For example Additional Maths, Further Maths Child Development.

## HOW MANY SUBJECTS ARE CHOSEN?

These are the subject areas to choose from...

- One Modern Foreign Language
- Four Open Choice Courses

Five options to choose in total, plus a reserve.



## MILLAIS SCHOOL

## ONE FROM EACH AREA DOESN'T SUIT ME!

You can choose two creative subjects like Drama \& Music.

Or two Humanities like Geography with History.
Some want Triple Science \& Additional Maths.

The only exceptions are DT subjects where coursework is very time consuming.

## MILLAIS SCHOOL

## OPTIONS CHOICES

- Students should select subjects that they enjoy \& are good at.
- Considering what may fit in with future career ideas.
- All students will receive an interview with a member of SLT to discuss their choices. These will take place on the week beginning 19 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ February.



## MILLAIS SCHOOL

WILL MY CHOICES AFFECT MY LONG TERM CAREER ASPIRATIONS?

Not in most cases but they could do. You may need to consider which subjects may be useful to you in your chosen career, if you have one.

## NEW SUBJECTS AT KS4

Taking a new subject is fine and may suit some students.

Make an informed choice.

Look at the course details, speak to subject teachers if you are unsure

## MILLAIS SCHOOL

HOW SHOULD I GET THE BALANCE RIGHT?

Its good to have a variety of subjects
Ideally, make one choice per section on the form.

This will then give students a balanced and varied workload.

## MILLAIS SCHOOL

WHICH TEACHERS WILL THEY HAVE FOR GCSES?

Simple answer: we don't know!

## MILLAIS SCHOOL

IF I CHOOSE THE SAME SUBJECTS AS MY FRIENDS WILL WE BE TOGETHER?

Probably not...
New groups are formed from all three bands of Year 9 for the Options.

## WILL I DEFINITELY GET MY FIRST CHOICE?

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Every effort will be made to make sure that students get their first choice but occasionally groups are too small and we cannot offer them.

Some combinations unfortunately won't fit into the timetable.

If we need to use your reserve choice we will speak to you about this individually.

## HOW LONG IS THERE LEFT TO CHOOSE OPTIONS?

Online options can be made when ready, but can be changed up until the end of Tuesday 5th March.

Parents will then be contacted to confirm the choices, made by their child.

After this date online choices become final.
