Welcome from Millais CAS

It is our pleasure to share our Enrichment Clubs programme for Term 2 of the 2023/24 academic year at Millais. We have some very exciting new clubs running this term including Creative Writing, Star Gymnastics and Year 9 Fast-track Drama. You can find more about them in the descriptions below. We also have had a couple of clubs removed from the timetable including Music Tech Club (replaced by Beauty and the Beast rehearsals), Rugby and Volleyball/Badminton (Years 7-9). There have been several room changes so please ensure you know where to go.

CAS is our Personal Development framework focusing on how students can develop their sense of Community, Action and Self. We hope our offer will give all students the opportunity to learn new skills, stay active, build positive relationships, and, most of all, have fun. All clubs are run by Millais staff on a voluntary basis and all after-school clubs run until 4pm.

The Learning Resource Centre (LRC) is open after school for independent study until 5pm Monday to Thursday (currently closed on a Friday).

If an After School Club is cancelled, we will endeavour to inform parents and students. Please note that students impacted by a cancelled club can always go to the LRC if required (except Friday's).

Millais staff also offer SPA (Supporting Pupil Achievement) sessions after school until 4pm to help students with their class subjects. A separate timetable for this offer is available on our [website](#).

Instrumental and Singing Lessons at Millais

As part of our extra-curricular provision at Millais, we also have a team of visiting music teachers who deliver one-to-one and small group music lessons. We can offer students lessons in singing, drums, piano, violin, viola, cello, double bass, flute, clarinet, saxophone, bassoon, trumpet, cornet, trombone, piano, guitar, bass guitar and drum kit.

Lessons take place during the normal school day for either 20 or 30 minutes on a rotary system. Funding can be available for those in receipt of free school meals.

Descriptions

Name	Description
Anime Club	A chance for fans of Anime and Studio Ghibli films to share interests and ideas. Watch film extracts, discuss the animations, design characters, and have fun!
Art Club	A great way for Year 9 students to express themselves creatively while learning new techniques and refining skills learnt in lessons.
Badminton and Volleyball	Non-competitive club for Years 10 and 11. Turn up in your PE kit and use the Badminton/ Volleyball courts.
Ball Games	Open to all Year 7's a fun lunch time session playing ball games. Either on the Astro or in the Sports Hall (weather dependant). Meet ALP in the Sports Hall at 12.50. Bring trainers but can wear school uniform.
Basketball	A club to develop your basketball skills, open to students in year 9. As spaces are limited, please speak to a member of the PE staff to sign up.
Basketball – GCSE Invitation	Invite only, specific coaching for GCSE PE students in preparation for their practical component of their GCSE PE course. Paid club via Parent Pay £2 per session.
Choir	Come and sing your hearts out. We will be doing a wide mix of songs and welcome your suggestions as well.
Christian Union	An opportunity to get to know other Christians in the school. There will be discussion, prayer and worship. Bring your lunch!
Creative Writing	Come and express yourself in a comfortable, supportive and inspiring environment of like-minded writers. There'll be opportunities to write, perform, generate ideas, and work together in an inventive and positive group.
Code Club	Learning programming in a fun and interactive way.
Dance Club	Develop your dance skills and learn new styles, in the dance studio, PE kit required, no socks or shoes!
Dance Club - GCSE	Session to work on and improve GCSE Dance choreography and set phrases.
Debate and Philosophy Club	Lunch time club discusses ethical issues, philosophy, politics, and current affairs. An area is then chosen from these discussions to inform the debate proposition. After school debate session then brings the previous weeks insights and thoughts to a full British Parliamentary Debate competition. Year 11s and 10s will be eligible to enter the Cambridge and Oxford Schools Debating competitions.
EAL	A safe space for students that have EAL. So they can express themselves, boost their English and meet other students that speak the same language. We will also discuss key vocabulary of different subjects.
E-Sport	Play esports on Nintendo switches, games include Mario Kart, Smash bros and Just dance.
Eco Committee	Help Millais achieve the Green Flag award. We will be monitoring and evaluating how eco-friendly the school is. We will also be working on some new eco initiatives to help us achieve the award. Bring your lunch!

Year 9 Fast-Track Drama	Fast-track is an invite only Drama club, aimed at providing Year 9 students with opportunity to strengthen and further develop their acting skills.
Football	All year groups welcome. Bring your PE kit, football boots and shin pads meet on the field. Must attend if you want to be a part of the Millais Football Teams.
Friday Lunch Club	A drop in club for anyone who wants to come and play games like Avocado Smash, Uno, Dobble and others or anyone who just wants to chat. Bring your lunch!
Geography GIS Ambassadors	Learn how to use Geographical Information Systems including Digimaps and ArcGis. Use your training to become a Millais GIS Ambassador helping other students to use the systems and become better geographers.

Star Gym Club	Mixed Ability Gymnastics class working on Floor, Tumbling and Vault skills. Class will be run by highly experience Level 2 and Level 3 coaches who can accommodate a large range of abilities.
