**Please note that the Post 16 Provider Open Event information may change – so please check the provider website for up to date information.**

**Key Information:**

- Spend time looking through the courses on offer with your child at establishments they are interested in applying to. Of most interest should be the **COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS** section. Your child should be ambitious, but realistic, regarding applications. The Post 16 providers place entry requirements on courses to ensure that each student is choosing to optimise their success.
- If your child feels that they may struggle reaching the entry requirements for a particular college / course, they should make a couple of Post 16 provider applications to ensure that they have a place for their post 16 studies just in case they do not reach the grades for their desired establishment.
- A reminder that a grade 4 in English Language and Maths is required to ensure that a student does not have to resit in Year 12.
- Students do not need to confirm where they are attending until after GCSE results day.
- **Most college applications will need to be submitted at some stage during the first term of Year 11 (see deadlines in table).**
- **Millais will need to be informed of any private school applications**, so we can prepare references for these early deadlines.
