SPRING TERM TOPICS - First half of Spring Term

Superpower relations and the Cold War 1941 - 1991

- **The origins of the Cold War 1941 – 1958:** the early tension between the USA and the USSR immediately after WW2 (eg the impact of the atomic bomb), the intensification of the Cold War (eg the arms race, tension over Berlin, the Hungarian Uprising)
- **Cold War crises 1958 – 1970:** The further increase in the Cold War and flash points (eg The Berlin Wall, The Cuban Missile Crisis and the Prague Spring)
- **The end of the Cold War 1970 – 1991:** The attempts to reduce tension between the USA and the USSR, and the eventual collapse of Soviet control of Eastern Europe (eg the impact of Gorbachev's new style of leadership, the fall of the Berlin Wall, the collapse of Russian Communist control in Eastern European countries)
