School Uniform List

School uniform identifies students with Millais School and should be worn with pride and a sense of responsibility.

The school has a clear and firm policy on uniform, and we ask parents to study it carefully and give it their full support. This avoids us having to spend valuable time reminding students about details or parents being involved in unnecessary expense by buying items of clothing which are unacceptable.

There is a revised change for the school uniform for the new Year 7 students. There will be a phased transition to the revised uniform for Y8,9, 10 & 11 in order to minimise costs for families avoid unnecessary replacement of uniform.

From September 2026: all students joining Y7 will wear the revised school uniform. Y8, 9, 10 & 11 will continue to wear the existing Millais uniform.

Please note students may choose to move to the revised uniform at any time if they wish (it must be all the stated items & not just a pick & mix version)

From September 2027: the revised uniform introduced for September 2026 will become the school's standard published uniform. Students who have a full set of compliant former style Millais uniform may continue to wear those items beyond September 2027. Provided that the uniform remains smart, serviceable and compliant with previous uniform policy, former style and revised uniform items are not to be combined.

BLAZER	Black Blazer with school logo
SKIRT	Green/Black Tartan school skirt (This must come 5cm below the knee)
TROUSERS/SHORTS	(Y7) Plain dark grey (charcoal or graphite shade) school-tailored trousers or shorts These may be worn as an alternative to the skirt (Y8-11) can continue to wear black trousers with school logo These may be worn as an alternative to the skirt
SWEATSHIRT JUMPER	(Y7) Green school sweatshirt with school logo (Y8-11) Black V neck jumper with school logo
SHIRT BLOUSE	(Y7) Plain white, collared, button-up shirt, short or long sleeved (Y8-11) White blouse with school logo
In order to avoid variation in style and colour parents are requested to purchase the branded items from the official stockists.	

TIGHTS/SOCKS	Autumn half term to end of Spring term: black ankle length socks (non-logo), black opaque tights Summer term to Autumn half term: black ankle length socks (non-logo) or flesh-coloured tights
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SHOES	Any comfortable black shoes or plain black trainers Shoes must not be above the ankle bone. Laces must be black. For safety reasons platforms, stiletto heels, sliders, sling backs, backless, Crocs, Heely's and open toed shoes are not permitted. In bad weather, boots may be worn to and from school but must be changed to shoes in school.
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COAT

Plain any colour, with no lettering etc and with a plain coloured lining. The coat must be long enough to cover the blazer

JEWELLERY

Plain wristwatch is permitted.

Students with pierced ears may wear one small pair of plain ear studs, 2mm in diameter only in the lobe of the ear. No other piercings are permitted unless authorised by the school. These must be removed for PE. Other studs and piercings, including nose and tongue studs are not permitted. Other jewellery must not be worn.

ALL ITEMS OF UNIFORM MUST BE FULLY NAMED / LABELLED**HAIR/MAKE-UP/NAILS**

Millais School has adopted the Halo Code. We recognise and celebrate the diversity of natural hair. Natural Afro-textured hair is welcomed, valued and will not be subject to discrimination. Protective and culturally significant hairstyles associated with Afro-textured hair, including, but not limited to, braids, cornrows, twists, locs, Bantu knots and plaits, are permitted, provided they are appropriate for the school environment and do not present a health and safety risk.

Students' hair should be of a natural colour, neatly styled and appropriate for the school environment. Long hair must be tied back where required for health and safety in practical lessons. Hairstyles that include shaved patterns, symbols, words, images or deliberately exaggerated styles are not permitted.

Make-up, nail varnish, false nails, false eyelashes and false eyebrows are not permitted. Headscarves worn for religious reasons should be plain black or green, unless an alternative has been agreed as a reasonable adjustment.

PE KIT

(Y7-11) Green/white PE polo shirt with logo

(Y7) School green crew neck sweatshirt may be worn for outdoor PE or a plain black sweatshirt without logos. Optional black base layer.

(Y8-11) Black plain sweatshirt. Optional black base layer.

(Y7) Plain black loose-fitting sports shorts, plain black leggings or tracksuit bottoms or skort.

(Y8-11) Black leggings with logo OR black training pants with logo OR black skort with logo.

(Y7-11) Black/white under knee socks for football and hockey.

White sports socks (netball and summer activities).

Trainers for indoor spaces, sports hall, hardcourt and Astroturf. Football boots.

Shin pads for hockey and football. Gum shield for hockey.

** Our uniform suppliers still have limited stocks of previously required branded PE items available for purchase. New year 7 parents are welcome to buy these items; however, there is no requirements to do so, and students are not expected to purchase discontinued PE clothing.
